VISITOR GUIDELINES

We look forward to your participation in our Educational Program and know we will all have a great time and enjoy learning about farming and food in the context of regional history, nutrition and conservation.

- 1. All group visits must be scheduled, Call Beth Ann Levendoski or Jonathan Reinbold at 760-742-4213 to register.**
- 2. We are in Pauma Valley about 25 minutes away from Escondido, the nearest city**
- 3. We have a farmers market but no restaurant with prepared food. Bringing your own picnic or sack lunch is necessary to have lunch on the farm.**
- 4. Tierra Miguel Foundation is a No Smoking facility.**
- 5. Please ensure that everyone has appropriate hats, outdoor clothes and closed toe shoes. Everyone needs an individual bottle of water to stay well hydrated. We have the water!**
- 6. Weather can vary from moderate to very hot or chilly, so be prepared with a layer (jacket or sweater) to put on or take off as the temperature changes.**
- 7. Please fix an adhesive nametag to the participants' shirts before arrival so we can know them by name and place it on their take-home item for your use upon returning.**
- 8. Tierra Miguel Farm is a working farm with real farm equipment. Playing on or touching of farm equipment without TMF staff supervision is not allowed.**
- 9. If it rains, there is a rainy day program with just as many exciting and informative activities as our outdoor program. There is no need to cancel your visit.**
